LEATHER STANDARD by OEKO -TEX®: New regulations in 2022

At the start of the year, the OEKO-TEX® Association as usual updates the applicable test criteria, limit values and requirements for its range of certifications and labels. The following new regulations for LEATHER STANDARD by OEKO-TEX® come into effect on April 1, 2022 after a three-month transition period:

<u>New additions to the limit value catalogue</u>

Chemicals added to the catalogue (Annex 4):

- Bisphenol B with a threshold value of 1'000 mg/kg
- Colourants with ≥ 0.1% Michlers Ketone / Base with a threshold value of 1'000 mg/kg
 - o 4,4'-bis(dimethylamino)-4''-(methylamino)trityl alcohol
 - \circ C.I. Solvent Blue 4

New under observation

The following substances will be put as "under observation" (Annex 4)

- Methylisothiazolinone (MIT):
- Bisphenol F
- Bisphenol S
- Bisphenol AF
- 2-Mercaptobenzothiazol (2-MBT)
- Disperse Red 60
